Important Note

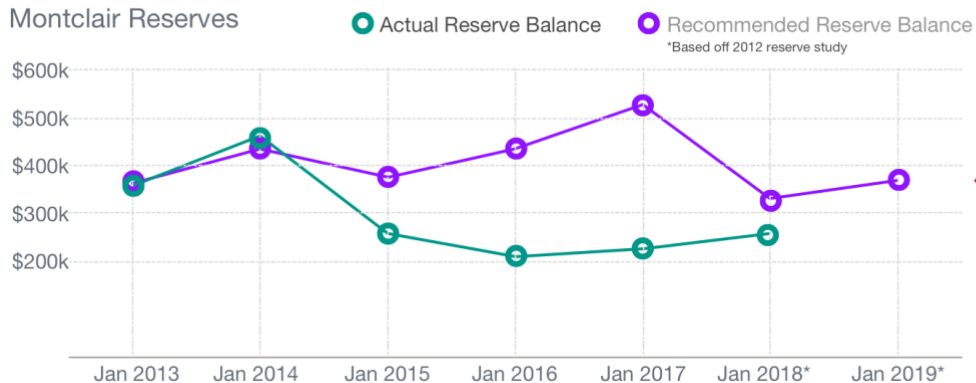
